Guiding Principles of Research Integrity

The CeRSP is a non-profit research institute supported by both public and private funding. It is an independent research facility and is committed to ensuring that research produced by the Center is of the highest professional standard and academic integrity. Researchers working for the CeRSP are expected to meet these standards in producing work for the Center.

Researchers associated with the CeRSP will follow the industry's 'best practices' including the impartial and objective service of academic research, documenting and making available their work, acknowledge the work and contributions of others, maintain a professional working environment, disclose the source of funding for their work, and avoid conflicts of interest or clearly state any relevant information (e.g. material relationships: financial, personal, or otherwise).

Scientific misconduct is untenable. Misconduct includes the fabrication or misinterpretation of results; misrepresentation, inappropriate manipulation, or modification of data; breach or appropriation of intellectual property of others (plagiarism; poor citation); use of other's work (including subordinates); and failure to secure fair and transparent peer-review.

In addition to the ethical and scientific norms of professional academic disciplines, researchers at CeRSP are expected to adhere to legal and contractual conditions of the place of work and residence.
